

QOV Mystery #29 – Clue 3

Cutting Instructions:

Background..... (3) 5 ¼” squares
 (1) 2 ½” x 31”
 (12) 2 ½” x 4 ½”
 (3) 4 ½” squares
 (12) 3 7/8” squares – draw a diagonal line on wrong side

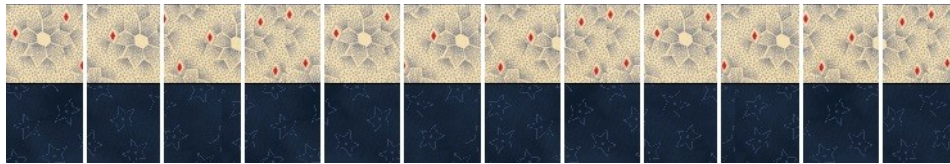
Dark Blue..... (1) 2 ½” x 31”

Red..... (3) 7 ¼”
 (12) 2 ½” x 4 ½”

Gold..... (12) 2 7/8” squares – draw a diagonal line on wrong side

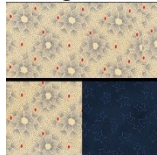
Sewing Instructions:

Sew (1) 2 ½” x 31” Background strip to (1) 2 ½” x 31” Dark Blue strip together lengthwise.
 Subcut into 2 ½” x 4 ½” units.



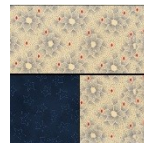
< 2 ½” > Make 12

Sew one of the above units to (1) 2 ½” x 4 ½” Background strip as shown:



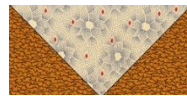
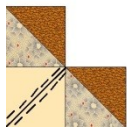
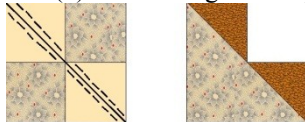
Make 6

Repeat, but rotate unit as shown:



Make 6

Make Flying Geese using the “No Waste Flying Geese Method” as in previous clues.
 Use (1) 5 ¼” Background square and (4) 2 7/8” Gold Squares.



Make 12 Your FG should measure 2 ½” x 4 ½”

Sew (1) FG unit to (1) 2 ½” x 4 ½” Red strip as shown:



Make 12

Assemble your block as shown:



Make 3

Your block should measure 12 1/2"

Make Flying Geese using method above. Use (1) 7 1/4" Red square and (4) 3 7/8" Background.



Make 12

Your FG should measure 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"

This ends Clue #3

Cutting Instructions for Clue #4

Background..... (3) 6 1/2" squares

(12) 3 7/8" squares – draw diagonal line on wrong side

(6) 4" squares – draw diagonal line on wrong side

Dark Blue..... (6) 4" squares

Red..... (3) 7 1/4" squares

Gold.....(12) 3 1/2" squares – draw diagonal line on wrong side
